Conversations with God Psalm 118:17-18

New American Standard Bible

17 I will not die, but live,
 And tell of the works of the LORD.
 18 The LORD has disciplined me

severely,

But He has not given me over to death.



- God's work lays me low and drives me to my knees
- Sin keeps me from seeing God rightly
- ➤ Pain often puts me in a place of desperate communion with God
- Real hope is here!
- > Hope with plans for a future
- > Hope that death will never be your end

Conversations with God Psalm 118:19-21 NAS

¹⁹ Open to me the gates of righteousness; I shall enter through them, I shall give thanks to the LORD. ²⁰ This is the gate of the LORD; The righteous will enter through it. ²¹ I shall give thanks to You, for You have answered me, And You have become my salvation

- Coming to God in prayer should always lead to thanksgiving; why?
- ➤ Because Christ's righteousness has become mine so I can come to His gates
- > Approach Him in righteous living
- > Hebrews 4:12-13



Psalm 118:22-24 NAS

²² The stone which the builders rejected

Has become the chief corner stone.

²³ This is the LORD'S doing;

It is marvelous in our eyes.

This is the day which the LORD has made;

Let us rejoice and be glad in it.



- Cornerstone = Christ; a reference to the completed work of Christ
- Christ is the first stone; if you reject Him you have no hope or basis for prayer
- Christ's work empowers and guarantees prayer
- "This is the day" = Any day we struggle and God saves us

Psalm 118:25-26 NAS

²⁵ O LORD, do save, we beseech You;

O LORD, we beseech You, do send prosperity!

²⁶ Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the LORD;

We have blessed you from the house of the LORD.

- ➤ Beseech= Pray with love, from love, respond in love
- ➤ Prosperity = Push forward; break out, be good; come in power
- ➤ Do save = Hoshiya na = Oh my gosh, SAVE ME!!
- Moved to mean salvation has come

Psalm 118:27

²⁷ The LORD is God, and He has given us light;

Bind the festival sacrifice with cords

to the horns of the altar.



- Give me light in all things and give me a love for the light
- Sacrifice; 2 meanings
- Our prayers are accepted because of the blood of Christ
- God, tie me to the altar so I don't stray!
- How much of what I pray about comes because I wander away?

Psalm 118:28-29 NAS

²⁸ You are my God, and I give thanks to You;

You are my God, I extol You.

²⁹ Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good;

For His lovingkindness is everlasting.

- Life is hard and many prayers are birthed from that
- This Psalm has served as a source of prayer and comfort for many...
