## John 4:23-24

23 Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. 24 God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth."



- God is seeking!
- Are you a TRUE WORSHIPPER?



- A.W. Tozer: To great sections of the church, the art of worship has been lost entirely, and in its place has come that strange and foreign thing called the "program".



- True worshipers worship in Spirit and in Truth
- In Spirit - the response that springs up from a heart that has been awakened by the Holy Spirit
- In Truth - the response that lines up with the truth of God's word
- In other words, it takes God to know God



- The story of the Samaritan woman is the story of every true worshiper
- Jesus didn't only tell her about true worshipers, but made her one as well!





## Romans 12:1

Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.

2 Every day I will praise you  
and extol your name for ever and ever.

3 Great is the Lord and most worthy of praise;  
his greatness no one can fathom.

4 One generation commends your works to another;  
they tell of your mighty acts.

5 They speak of the glorious splendor of your majesty—  
and I will meditate on your wonderful works.

6 They tell of the power of your awesome works—  
and I will proclaim your great deeds.

7 They celebrate your abundant goodness  
and joyfully sing of your righteousness.

- **John 3:16-17**

16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.

- We must stop being so easily satisfied and pursue the greater joy!
