1 Corinthians 11:23-26

The Lord's Supper

23 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; 24 and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me." 25 In the same way He took the cup also after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me." 26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.

**Luke 22:15- “I have eagerly desired to eat this
Passover with you”**

**The Lord’s Supper is fellowship/communion with
Jesus**

Christ wants to sit and fellowship with us!

**The Gospel and Word of God become more real to
you- you truly experience the realness of it**

**God created us so we would experience his love for
us**

Who would you eat your last meal with?

Jesus chose his disciples...and us!

We call it the Eucharist- why?

Eucharist = give thanks; why are we thanking God?

That God has worked in us and we remember

Have you remembered this week?

We remember to be thankful for Jesus

**We remember to be thankful that what he did was
for us**

We remember to be thankful for his great love

We remember to be thankful that we are his people

**We remember to be thankful that we can commune
with God**

**We do all of this as a family; part of Communion is
to remember that we are eating with our family**

v. 26 - Until he comes

1 - There's another meal!! Rev. 19:6-9

2 - We won't eat this meal any more

We won't remember and we won't look forward

We will be complete and we will be WITH JESUS!
