# SERMON NOTES

## HEBREWS 10 & 11 (NASB)

HEBREWS 10:35-39

35 Therefore, do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward. 36 For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God, you may receive [a]what was promised. 37 For yet in a very little while, He who is coming will come, and will not delay. 38 But My righteous one shall live by faith; And if he shrinks back, My soul has no pleasure in him. 39 But [b]we are not of those who shrink back to destruction, but of those who have faith to the [c]preserving of the soul.

- Paul is writing to say, don't throw in the towel, don't give up, instead have endurance. Remember Captain America - I can do this all day. He then gets to the point of the story in verse 38. But my righteous one shall live by faith.

- Who are the righteous?

- 2 Corinthians 5:21 - He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.
- Romans 1:16-18 - 16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. 17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "But the righteous man shall live by faith."

- Unbelief and Its Consequences. 18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

- What is faith and how does it work?

- Hebrews 11:1 - Now faith is the assurance (or substance) of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

- Faith must have substance.

# SERMON NOTES

## HEBREWS 10 & 11 (NASB)

- What is faith - It is the evidence, proof, or conviction which enables us to perceive unseen things just as if they were seen, to sense spiritual realities just as truly as we sense things by seeing, smelling, hearing and touching. Through faith, unseen things take on substance, and future things take on reality.
- The amount of faith you have is not tied to how much faith you actually possess. But rather it's tied to how much substance you possess.
  - Matthew 17:20 - And He \*said to them, "Because of the littleness of your faith; for truly I say to you, if you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible to you.
- A little faith in the proper substance will bring about great results. A lot of faith in insufficient substance will bring about no results. Because what makes faith what it is is the subject or the substance it is attached to.
- What is our subject? Who is the subject calling for the faith?  
God
- There are things we must know about God if we are to truly experience God.
- Faith is acting like God is telling the truth
  - Hebrews 11:2 - For by it the men of old gained approval.
  - Hebrews 11:3 - By faith we understand that the worlds were prepared by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things which are visible.
  - Matthew 8:8 - But the centurion said, "Lord, I am not worthy for You to come under my roof, but just say the word, and my servant will be healed."

*Hebrews 10 & 11*

## HEBREWS 10 & 11 (NASB)

- Faith is not seeing what is not there but seeing through doubt and sin to see what God has promised through His son Jesus Christ.
  - Faith claims the future as the present. Through faith, unseen things take on substance, and future things take on reality.
- It is by faith we hold the clear title to the property of salvation.

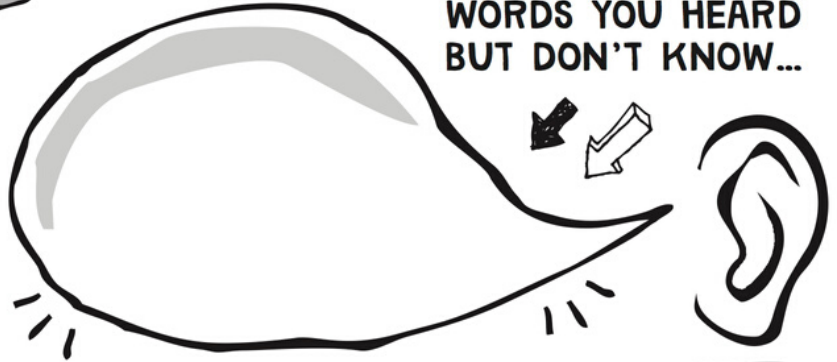
