SERMON NOTES

HEBREWS 12:12-24

- Hebrews drives us to ask, "What am I doing here?"
- Hebrews drives us to daily trust; to heart and life-change
- Hebrews drives us to run the race together with endurance

HEBREWS 12:12-17

12 Therefore, strengthen the hands that are weak and the knees that are feeble, 13 and make straight paths for your feet, so that the limb which is lame may not be put out of joint, but rather be healed. 14 Pursue peace with all men, and the sanctification without which no one will see the Lord. 15 See to it that no one comes short of the grace of God; that no root of bitterness springing up causes trouble, and by it many be defiled; 16 that there be no immoral or godless person like Esau, who sold his own birthright for a single meal. 17 For you know that even afterwards, when he desired to inherit the blessing, he was rejected, for he found no place for repentance, though he sought for it with tears.

vv.12-13; Who has weak knees and feeble hands?

- Strengthen yourself
- Strengthen each other
- Who needs to be strengthened? Who can I strengthen?

vv. 14-17; The goal is that an entire local church not shrink back

- That the center of TSF would be the cross of Christ
- All together we will make sure no one falls!
- We cannot make it if we take Christianity casually

HEBREWS 12:18-22

18 For you have not come to a mountain that can be touched and to a blazing fire, and to darkness and gloom and whirlwind, 19 and to the blast of a trumpet and the sound of words which sound was such that those who heard begged that no further word be spoken to them. 20 For they could not bear the command, "If even a beast touches the mountain, it will be stoned." 21 And so terrible was the sight, that Moses said, "I am full of fear and trembling." 22 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to myriads of angels,

HEBREWS 12:12-24

- Run with endurance because of who and where we worship
- The old mountain- Sinai
 - They want to retreat to something they can touch, see and hear
 - It will only keep them away from God!
- The new mountain- Zion
 - The place where all true believers in Jesus worship him
 - We are gathering at Mt Zion today!

HEBREWS 12:22-24

22 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to myriads of angels, 23 to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the Judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect, 24 and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood, which speaks better than the blood of Abel.

- Who is at Mt Zion with us?
 - Believers from all places and all times
 - Innumerable angels in their party clothes!
 - Jesus the "firstborn"
 - God the "Judge"
 - Jesus the "mediator"
- What is this comment about Abel telling us?
 - Abel died seeking God's acceptance; Jesus died guaranteeing God's acceptance for all who come to him through faith in Christ
 - You can have a big show and feel good experiences if you leave this Mt Zion church
 - Or you can have direct access to God through the blood of Jesus without trying to get God to accept you on your own!
 - Draws our attention back to vv. 12-17 to see what worship looks like every day

SERMON NOTES

HEBREWS 12:12-24

- The mountain we come to is better!
 - Jesus made a way for us to come near to God
 - We have direct access to God
 - Our names are enrolled- a pass to get in to God with Jesus!
- The new way of approaching God in what we can't see, handle, or hear is BETTER
 - We must worship him, trust him, live for him- every day we are standing on holy ground!
- Strengthen your arms and knees; fix your eyes on Jesus; pursue holiness; trust him~
- With ALL of the enrolled, worship Jesus now and every day!
- Your whole life is holy ground- come near to him!
- Jesus has made a way for you to come to God as Father and friend!






