²¹ "His master replied, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!'




- During Jesus' last week on earth, he's trying to impart a special truth to his followers:

- If we're not careful, we can get stuck in the ditch of "i'll never be good enough"




- 2. We are not all gifted in the same ways we all have differing levels of ability and expertise.

- God isn't looking at how much you produce, but for you to be intentional with what you have.




- 3) Risk is always involved in using your talents.

- Play the long game and put yourself in position to invest and reap over the long term.




