After calling believers to contend for the faith and help others remain faithful, Jude closes with a powerful reminder of God's ability to keep His people. These final verses turn our attention from what we are called to do to the God who is able to guard, sustain, and ultimately bring His people into His presence with joy.

5. Which description of God in these verses gives you the most confidence? Why?
6. What is the difference between trusting ourselves to remain faithful and trusting God to keep us?
7. Why do you think Jude ends a letter filled with warnings by focusing on God's ability to keep His people?

LIVING IT OUT

8. Where are you most tempted to rely on your own strength rather than God's power?
9. How could greater confidence in God's ability to keep you change the way you face temptation, uncertainty, or spiritual opposition?
10. What truth from Jude 24–25 do you most need to remember this week?
